Ethiopia – We praise God for his providence in our work in Ethiopia! The food aid that has been delayed due to the blocking of the roads by the rebel forces has now reached families in need. Pray that everything else would go smoothly in this project, and that we would be able to reach and help more vulnerable people.

South Sudan – Pray for our partner, the Centre for Emergency Development Support (CEDS), as they continue to provide aid to the people affected by violence and war. Pray for protection for our partners and the people in South Sudan from the pandemic, and also from the dangers of the war. Pray that peace will prevail in this country and that the conflict between the government and the rebels would be resolved.

India – We continue to praise the Lord for the recovery of Ramesh, executive director of our local partner EFICOR, who had a tumor removed from his brain recently. He is now able to go back to his duties and responsibilities.

Please also pray for EFICOR’s upcoming annual planning and audit, that everything would go well and that God would continue to lead them in their work. Pray for their protection as well, as they continue to serve the most vulnerable in India.

DR Congo – Our partner in the Congo, the Baptist Church of Central Africa, is asking for prayers as the schools re-

open after closing down due to the pandemic. Pray that everything will go smoothly as they navigate the “new normal” and pray that the students and staff would be safe.

Liberia – Pray for our local partner in Liberia, the Association of Evangelicals of Liberia (AEL), as they respond to the aftermath of the second wave of COVID-19 a few months ago. Pray for their staff’s safety as well as the people who have been infected by the virus. Pray for healing and sustenance, and that they would see God’s hands moving in this time of need.

Pray also that donations would continue to come in so that they’ll be able to implement their projects in Liberia.

Funding Proposals – Please pray for the recent proposals that were submitted from our program team. A lot of work and preparations went into them, and we are hoping for a positive response. Pray that God would work through these possible funding opportunities to help many people around the world.
